### Sources of Income



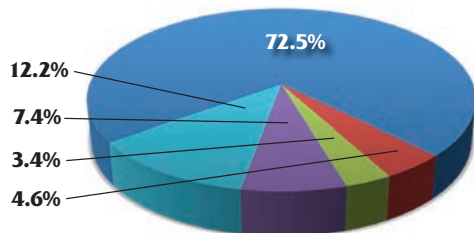

### **Family Promise Metrowest Establishes Transitional Housing Program**

her two children, Yaiki and Kayden. In October of 2012, Joana moved from FPM's shelter program into her new home. Between October 2012 and October 2013, FPM provided Joana with weekly case management, support services and rental, childcare and transportation subsidies. Joana graduated from FPM's pilot TH Program in October of 2013 with a steady job, stable home and savings for the future!

The model worked and we knew we needed to offer TH to other families in our shelter. In last year's Annual Report we let our supporters know that we had raised the initial \$10,000 of the \$45,000 needed to formally establish the TH Program. True to form, you responded and the \$45,000 was raised by October 2013! The funds were raised through our Mother's Day Appeal, Christ Lutheran Church's Sweet Sounds Concert, the Village Churchwomen, individual donors and grants from the Foundation for Metrowest and Eastern Bank. Thank you!

The funds were raised in time to offer TH to Jesula and her sons, John and Jay. We hope to be able to move more families out of shelter sooner and into their own apartments through our growing TH program.



***Joana's Journey*** My journey started when my children and I came from Puerto Rico and we tried to get some help from the DTA office. We spent all day in the office hungry and tired. It was a long wait hoping that they will help us. They finally called me in and told me that they cannot help me or my kids, and that there was a big chance that they will take my children away from me because I don't have a place to call home and a warm bed for them. They gave me a list of places I could call to check if they have a space for us. I started calling and nothing. Then I called Family Promise and Marcia answered the phone. She told me that I have to come in for an interview with my children first. I was so happy. She called me the day after the interview and said that we were accepted into the program. I was so happy. The next morning, Jerry (FPM van driver), picked us up at the hotel room I was renting. My life changed.

It was a big change. This was my first time in a shelter and there were so many rules and the moving from church to church, I think how will I do this with no job in a new place. I told myself, "You can do this not for you, for your children. They need you to do it." To make this long story short, I have to say it is not easy to be in this situation. I was in the program almost 2 years (in both the Shelter and TH Programs) but it has worked.

I made a lot of friends. I want to say to all the volunteers, thanks so much for all you have done for us and so many other families. Thank you for the many dinners, warm beds, the time you spent with my children and for listening to our problems. I want to say to a few good friends a special thanks; Jerry, Cheryl, Jeff, Marcia, Kim Ho, Mary Ann, Hannah, Annette, Beth, Sarah and her wonderful parents, and so many others that I am sorry I don't remember all the names. Thanks so much, you are part of my family. This program helped me to be a better mother, friend, person and to find myself. I have a great job; I'm a line cook now. My children are doing great at school. Yaikiria is in 5th grade, she just turned 11 in February and Kayden is in kindergarten. He will be 6 in June. I am getting married in August! To those who are attending my wedding, I will see you soon. Thank you Family Promise and Marcia for giving me confidence in myself. I love you guys and I miss you so much. Thank you to the person who donated the money to fund me in the Transitional Housing Program, it was a great help. Keep helping others!

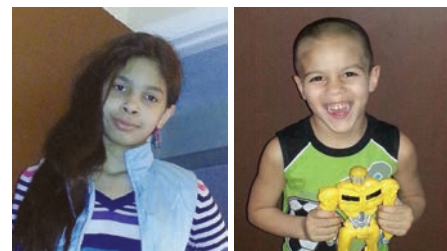
## ***Jesula, John and Jay – From Homelessness to Home***

**Family Promise Metrowest means a lot to me. My sons and I came here in April 2013 when we found we had no place to stay. Not knowing where we would sleep, shower or eat was very hard. Family Promise was my angels, my Godsend.**

When I entered the program, I was unsure of how it would work. I thought, 'You're homeless, you go in and sleep and then get out. Come back and sleep at night and then get out.' I worried in a shelter, where would we shower? How would I keep buying and cooking food? How would the kids do their homework? Then I came here and Family Promise took all that worry away from me.

To do what they do for perfect strangers is unbelievable – I did not expect it to be like that. The volunteers are all strangers. They don't know us but they leave their own lives to spend time with us and make us comfortable. It is amazing. Dinner time with volunteers and other Family Promise families feels like a real family having dinner and conversation together.

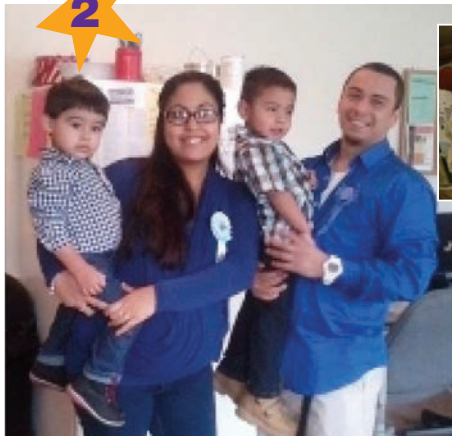
## Our Current Families
